These tools can be used for both individual & group evangelism.

Individual Evangelism

- 1. Select the appropriate language or dialect link and forward the video to your friends, relatives, loved ones or even strangers via their smartphones
- 2. Where possible, watch the video with them and be ready to answer to any questions posed
- 3. If they are willing, lead them to say the guided prayers (firstly with regards to their salvation follow by their personal urgent needs).
- 4. You may let them attempt the 50 easy-to-answer questionnaire and submit the answers (please note that the marks achieved is not important; the key is for them to go through the questions)
- 5. After that, please click 'view score'. The answers and explanations will pop up together with bible verses for further references.
- 6. Please discuss with them any questions posed.
- 7. There is no need to complete the questionnaire at one go. The key is to have a thorough discussion on the subject rather than rush through.
- 8. You may bring along your church members to join in at appropriate time, so that in time to come when you invite them to church, he/she will see familiar faces.
- 9. Above are some suggestions that you and your church may employ as deem fit for the ministry.

Group Evangelism

- 1. These tools can also be used in gatherings of all kinds where members can invite unbelievers to attend (eg cell group, youth meetings etc)
- 2. You can use a screen or white wall to project the video. It is advisable to try out the screening first.
- 3. Depending on your targeted audiences, we have videos in different languages or dialects for you to choose from. (We will continue to update and add on more languages in our link).
- 4. We suggest to have a moderator to introduce the video and to motivate/lead the response to prayers (please note that there are 2 prayers; one for salvation and another prayer for their specific urgent needs)
- 5. If time permits like in a camp setting or home cell meeting, you can attempt to do the questionnaires together.

- 6. After submitting the questionnaires, click 'view score' and then you can proceed to discuss each question with explanation attached (marks are not the important part, the key is to have them engaged in a good discussion on the subject)
- 7. The moderator can end with a prayer for all (summing up the prayers that they have made to God)
- 8. The moderator can encourage them to download the video and the questionnaires so that they can view the video and attempt the questionnaires again on their own.
- 9. Those who invited these "seekers" may then follow-up by helping them individually with further discussion on the questionnaires.
